AIRHOGS STADIUM 1600 Lone Star Pkwy Grand Prairie, TX 75050	From Interstate 30 take Belt Line Road Northbound. Proceed 1/4 mile and turn right at Gate 2 for general parking.	Both teams responsible for picking up trash in their respective dugouts <u>and</u> bleacher area.
CEDAR VALLEY JC 3030 N. Dallas Rd (Lancaster) Dallas Mapsco 76-P	From IH-20 in south Dallas take the Lancaster Rd. exit which is just east of IH-35E. Go south approx. 2 miles and field will be on the left next to the college.	Both teams responsible for picking up trash in their respective dugouts <u>and</u> bleacher area. Home team will rake the mound and home plate area. LAST GAME SHOULD LOCK GATE.
CHIESL PARK 11911 Ryliecrest (Balch Springs)	Traveling on I20, exit Seagoville Road (#481), and turn South. This exit is just past where I20 and I635 "merge" for a short distance. Go South on Seagoville Road approximately 1/8 mile, and turn West (right) on Rylie Crest Drive. Go West on Rylie Crest Road approximately 3/4 mile, you will see the complex.	Both teams responsible for picking up trash in their respective dugouts <u>and</u> bleacher area.
FOSSIL RIDGE HS 4101 Thompson Rd(Keller) Ft. Worth Mapsco 36E	From NE Loop 820, take N. Beach St north approximately 3.25 miles to Thompson. Go left on Thompson. School will be on the right. From I-35, take Western Center Blvd. east to N. Beach St. Go north on N. Beach to Thompson. Go left on Thompson.	Both teams responsible for picking up trash in their respective dugouts <u>and</u> bleacher area. Home team will rake the mound, home plate area, and baselines.
LEWISVILLE HS 1098 W. Main St. (Lewisville) Dallas Mapsco 650K	From I-35E exit Main Street. Go west approximately 1.5 Miles. School will be on the left. The field is in the back of the school campus.	Both teams responsible for picking up trash in their respective dugouts <u>and</u> bleacher area. Home team will rake the mound, home plate area, and baselines. LAST GAME SHOULD LOCK GATE.
LIVELY PARK FIELD 909 O'Connor Rd. (Irving) Dallas Mapsco 31B-P	From Hwy 183 (Airport Frwy) take O'Connor Rd. south to 3rd light (approx. 1¼ mile). Turn right into Lively Park and follow road to the right around Rec Center.	Both teams responsible for picking up trash in their respective dugouts <u>and</u> bleacher area. Home team will rake the mound, home plate area, and baselines.
NOLAN HS 4501 Bridge St. (Ft. Worth) FW Mapsco 65V	From I-30 East of downtown Ft. Worth west of 820 you will take the Oakland exit. As you approach Oakland the school and field will be on the right.	Both teams responsible for picking up trash in their respective dugouts <u>and</u> bleacher area. Home team will rake the mound, home plate area, and baselines.
NORTHLAKE JC (Irving) Dallas Mapsco 21B-S	From Hwy 183 (Airport Frwy) take Macarthur Blvd. north from the hwy. Field is located approx. 2½ miles on the left. If coming from the north, from IH-635 or Hwy 114, exit Macarthur Blvd. and go south until you see the field and school on the right.	Both teams responsible for picking up trash in their respective dugouts <u>and</u> bleacher area. Home team will rake the mound, home plate area, and baselines. LAST GAME SHOULD LOCK GATE.
TEXAS STAR 1501 S. Pipeline Rd. (Euless) Ft. Worth Mapsco 55-S	From Hwy 183 take Hwy 157 (Industrial Blvd) south approximately 2 miles to South Pipeline Rd. Go west (right) on South Pipeline Rd about 1 mile. Fields will be on the left.	Both teams responsible for picking up trash in their respective dugouts <u>and</u> bleacher area.
TRINITY VALLEY HS 7500 Dutch Branch Rd. (Ft. Worth) FW Mapsco 88X	From I-20 in SW Ft. Worth take the Bryant Irvin Rd. exit. Go south on Bryant Irvin Rd to Dutch Branch Rd. You will see the school on the left. Do not go into the gated parking lot. Instead park on the Dutch Branch Rd. side.	Both teams responsible for picking up trash in their respective dugouts <u>and</u> bleacher area.
VALLEY RIDGE PARK 2850 Park Ridge Dr. (Cedar Hill)	From Dallas take I-20 to Hwy 67 south towards Cleburne. Exit Lakeridge Pkwy and go west to Park Ridge. Go left on Park Ridge to the field. From FW take I-20 to Great SW Parkway. Go south across two bridges over Joe Poole Lake. Great SW Pkwy will split and become Lakeridge Pkwy. After second bridge take Lakeridge Pkwy south to Park Ridge. Go right about 1/4 mile. Field will be on the left.	Home team is responsible for putting the pitching tarp back on the mound. Both teams responsible for picking up trash in their respective dugouts <u>and</u> bleacher area

NOTES

1. Bases will be provided by the home team of each game. Visiting teams should bring their set of bases as a precaution. Some fields will be providing bases and you may use the set that is there. Teams forgetting their bases or not bringing them are subject to being fined.
2. Each home team is responsible for taking care of the field after the game. Even if you are not the last game of the day. Trash will be picked up by both teams. This includes the dugout and the bleacher areas. Teams are subject to being fined if the field is not maintained.
3. Leave the fields and grounds in better shape than you find them. When raking the plate area and pitcher's mound, be sure to fill in the holes. Don't just brush the rake over the area. Also when raking the baselines, you should rake from base to base, not across the basepath. Please be diligent picking up your trash.
4. Always insert the base plugs back into the supports after you remove the bases.
5. The last game of the day should make sure the field looks great. The coaches of the high schools should come on Monday and the fields be immaculate!
6. Before leaving the fields after the last game, double check to see that all sheds and gates are secured.
7. **NO PEPPER GAMES OR HITTING AGAINST THE FENCE!** Teams are subject to being fined if caught hitting into the fence.
8. No warm ups on infield grass or in front of the dugout. Please warm up in the outfield.
9. Do not pitch batting practice from the area in front of the mound.
10. **Never** climb or jump fences, cut locks, remove gates, or similar actions to gain access to a field.

**Most combinations to the locks on each field are 6-4-3-2.
